EXPENDITURES

Personnel costs are normally the largest cost for any business and the police department is no exception in this arena. Due to the nature of law enforcement, not being able to predict call activity to any certainty, criminal activity causing overtime for investigative reasons, and for safety reasons (having to replace officers when they are unable to fill a scheduled shift due to sickness, injury, or other reason) the department’s overtime costs are always a concern. Management attempts to minimize these costs as much as possible. Listed below is the monthly overtime costs year to date.

The police department exceeded our overtime budget by \$69,078.41 due to staffing shortages. But, due to the staffing shortages the department was under our wages budget by \$108,936.19.

In addition to the above table, we are providing a greater detail of the type of overtime the department incurs on a monthly basis. The first table (OT by type) indicates what type of overtime the department incurred. The types of overtime are defined as:

OT-Court: Overtime associated with an officer attending municipal or criminal court or an officer acting as a Court Officer for municipal court.

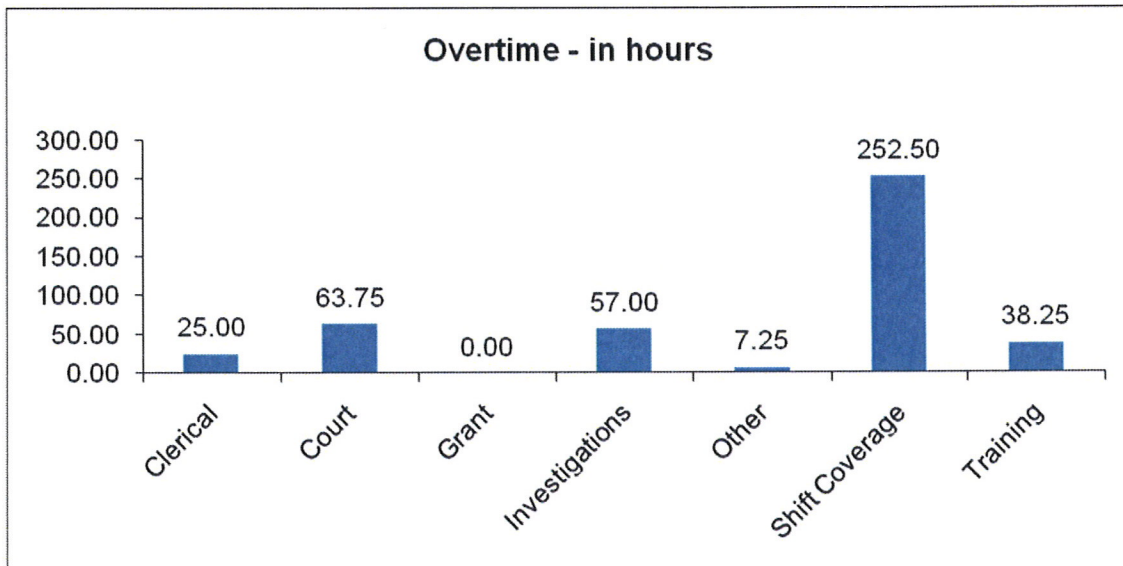
OT-Grant: The department is normally reimbursed from another agency for overtime-related costs in these categories.

OT-Investigations: Includes all overtime related to investigations (shift extension, early call-in, investigations)

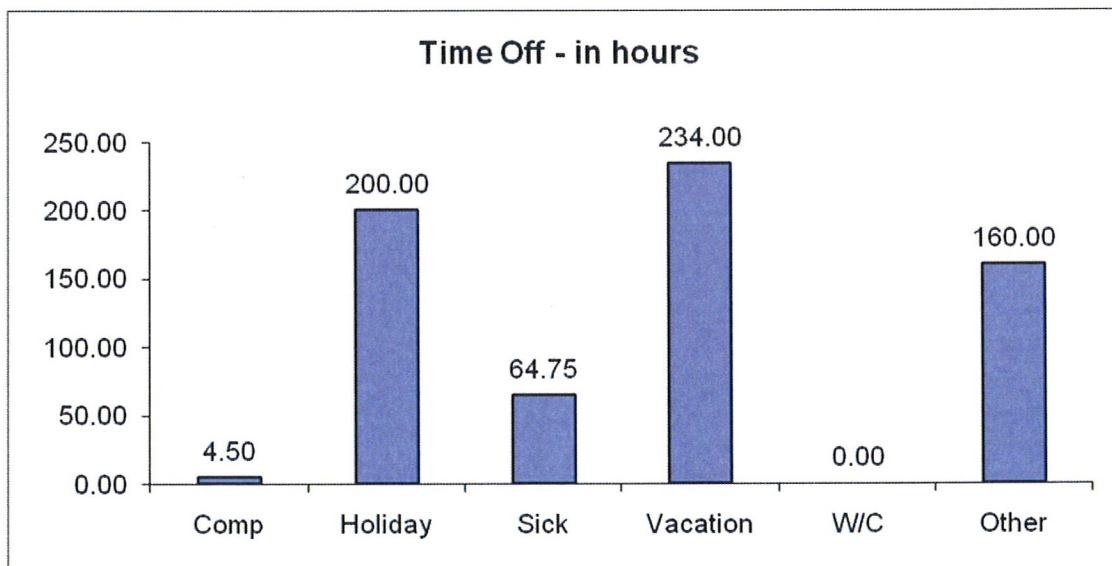
OT-Other: Uncategorized overtime

OT-Shift Coverage: All overtime related to filling in for an officer who is on vacation, sick, holiday, or otherwise unavailable to work the regularly scheduled shift.

OT-Training: Includes all overtime related to that individual officer to attend training



This table explains why an officer may not have appeared to work for their regularly scheduled shift. Time Off Other includes bereavement, **military**, admin. leave, suspension, or other unpaid time off.



Noteworthy Cases:

On December 5, 2008, Officer Brown was dispatched to the U.W. Hospital to contact a female victim. The victim was injured in a sexual assault that occurred on Parker Place. The victim informed Officer Brown that she was at home, when a male who has been known by her as a family friend for the past 12 years as Reginald Moore. Moore came to the door and she let him in; they began having a conversation when she received a phone call. Moore asked her to hang up and when she didn't, he grabbed the phone out of her hand and dropped it on the floor. He then pressed against her and began unbuttoning her pants. He pushed her down and used his forearms to hold her there. Moore then sexually assaulted her, even though she told him to stop and was struggling to get away from him. Reginald Moore was subsequently arrested and charged with 2 counts of 2nd degree sexual assault. Moore plead no contest to 4th degree sexual assault and disorderly conduct. He was sentenced to 9 months in jail with Huber privileges. (Case # 08-358149)

On December 13, 2008, Officer Pucillo and Officer Stephens were dispatched to a Town of Madison tavern to investigate a report of a fight in progress. On arriving, the officers observed a male subject being held down on the floor by several subjects. The officers recognized this subject as Vadon Brown who has been arrested several times previously by this agency for battery. The officers learned that Brown had been fighting with another subject when the bar manager and the bartender broke up the fight and separated the combatants. Vadon Brown then suddenly punched the bartender in the face and then punched him with a closed fist two more times. The bar manager attempted to help the bartender remove Brown and he was punched on the forehead. Brown was arrested and charged with 3 counts of battery and disorderly conduct. Brown plead no contest to three counts of battery. His sentence was to be consecutive with other cases he plead to with the court. (Case # 08-363859)

On December 29, 2008, Officer Mansavage and Pucillo were sent to Badger Lane to check on a report of a subject being loud and trying to fight people. Officer Mansavage contacted a male victim who was bleeding from the face. The victim reported that an acquaintance, identified as Robert Wedig, had injured him. The victim stated that he is recovering from back surgery and a fall or back injury could paralyze him. The suspect, Wedig, knows this and was in the parking lot yelling at another subject when he attacked the victim, pushing him to the ground. The victim fearful of a back injury began walking away and the suspect came up from behind him and pushed him down again and then began punching and kicking him while he was on the ground. Officer Pucillo located the suspect and he began running from Officer Pucillo, Officer Mansavage intercepted the suspect and took him into custody. Robert Wedig was arrested and charged with battery, disorderly conduct and obstructing and resisting an officer. This case is pending. (Case # 08-380289)

On December 29, 2008, Officer Garton and Parks were dispatched to a Pheasant Ridge Trail address to investigate a report of a disturbance. The officers found a male victim covered in blood stumbling out of a building. The victim collapsed outside near the front entrance. Officer Garton noted he had numerous cuts and slashes, one extremely deep and open on his forearm. Officer Garton retrieved a towel and applied pressure to this wound to keep the subject from bleeding to death. The victim advised that an unknown male and a female whom he knows as "Crystal" had stabbed him and had ran behind the building to the west. Officer Parks followed bloody footprints for a block to where they entered a building and then lost the trail. The victim states he had a large amount of money in his sock, which the female knew he was in possession of. She had come over earlier and they had smoked crack and she had taken him into the bathroom to give him oral sex in return for the crack. While

inside the bathroom the male suspect came in and opened the bathroom door and began slashing and cutting the victim. He was able to get the suspect to drop the knife at which time the female picked it up and began slashing him. Both suspects then went through his clothing and stole his money. A woman outside of the apartment in the hallway began yelling that she was going to call the police and both suspects jumped out of the apartment second story window and ran. Detective Searls and Bongiovani were able to identify both suspects and obtained a court order to track the female suspect's cell phone. The phone was traced to Janesville where members of the U.S. Marshals Service Fugitive Task Force, along with Bongiovani and Searls, located them in a motel room and arrested them. Crystal Mathis and Tracey L. Wilson were charged with armed robbery and first degree causing great bodily harm by use of a dangerous weapon. This case is still pending. (Case # 08-380461)

On December 31, 2008 Officer Stephens was requested to respond to the U.W. Hospital Emergency Room to contact a female victim of a battery. The victim reported that she was at a work Christmas party with her co-workers and she offered to give her manager, Joshua Hartwig, a ride home due to his intoxicated state. The victim transported him to his Landmark Place address and upon arriving asked her if she was staying. The victim indicated she was calling someone to pick her up at which time he grabbed her tightly by the wrists and dragged her out of the vehicle. The victim braced herself against the steering wheel and he used a karate chop on her leg to get hers out of the vehicle. Once out, he dragged her to the rear of the vehicle causing her to lose her shoes. He picked her shoes up and threw them into the vehicle and then locked the doors with her keys, wallet and shoes inside. He then said, "You can freeze bitch" and ran to his apartment inside the building, leaving her without shoes, locked outside in the freezing cold weather. The victim was able to obtain help and got a ride to the hospital where she was treated for numerous bruises and scrapes from the incident. Joshua Hartwig was arrested and charged with battery and disorderly conduct. This case is still pending. (Case # 08-382283)

Personnel Information

Police chief interviews were held with police applicants. Background investigations were ordered for two of the applicants. One applicant withdrew due to being hired by another police agency. The other applicant was placed on an eligibility list.

Training

As with many other departments throughout Dane County, the State of Wisconsin, and the nation, police officer training is a hot topic, especially with the current budget situation in the state and our community. The department has made a commitment to our officers and community to constantly update their training as much as possible. Knowing that training is a budget item it is the department's desire to let the town board and community know how this money is being spent and what training is being offered to our officers.
