EXPENDITURES

Personnel costs are normally the largest cost for any business; the police department is no exception in this arena. Due to the nature of law enforcement, not being able to predict call activity to any certainty, criminal activity causing overtime for investigative reasons, and for safety reasons (having to replace officers when they are unable to fill a scheduled shift due to sickness, injury, or other reason) the department's overtime costs are always a concern. Management attempts to minimize these costs as much as possible. Listed below is the monthly overtime costs year to date.

In addition to the above table, we are providing a greater detail of the type of overtime the department incurs on a monthly basis. The first table (OT by type) indicates what type of overtime the department incurred. The types of overtime are defined as:

OT-Court: Overtime associated with an officer attending municipal or criminal court or an officer acting as a Court Officer for municipal court.

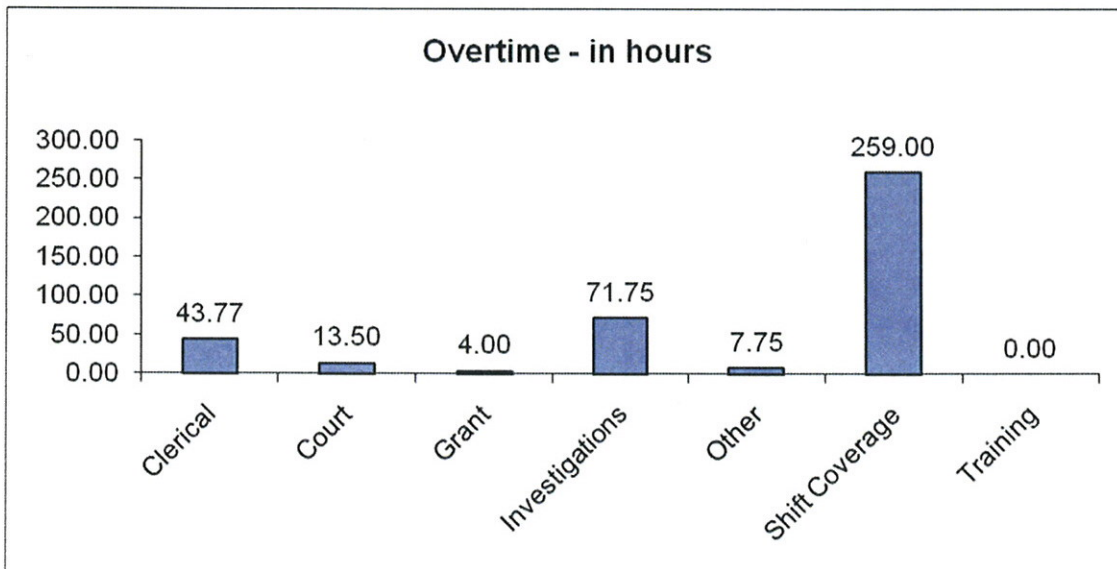
OT-Grant: The department is normally reimbursed from another agency for overtime-related costs in these categories.

OT-Investigations: Includes all overtime related to investigations (shift extension, early call-in, investigations)

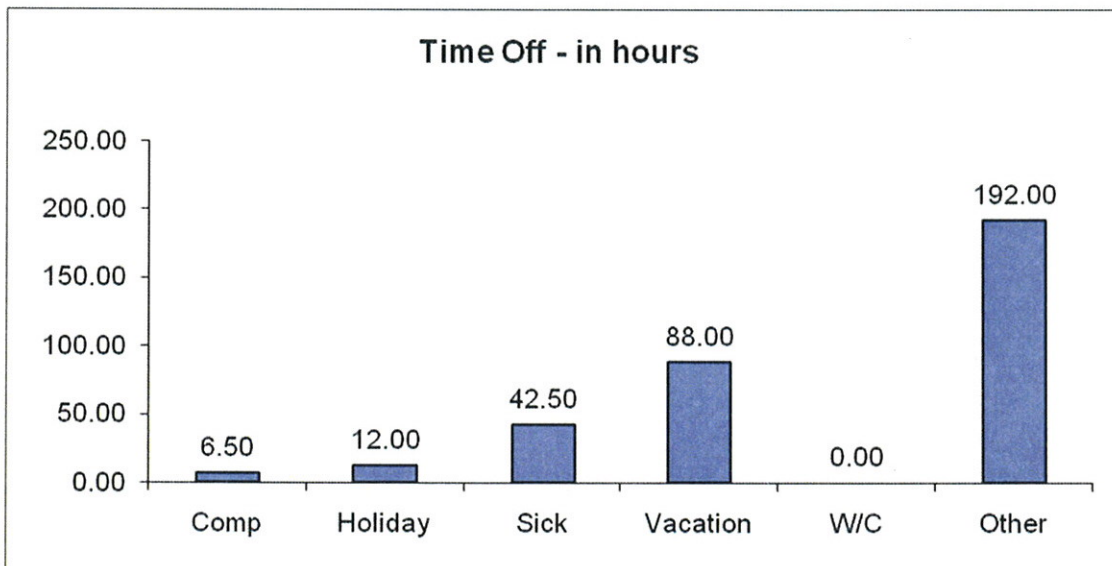
OT-Other: Uncategorized overtime

OT-Shift Coverage: All overtime related to filling in for an officer who is on vacation, sick, holiday, or otherwise unavailable to work the regularly scheduled shift.

OT-Training: Includes all overtime related to that individual officer to attend training



This table explains why an officer may not have appeared to work for their regularly scheduled shift. Time Off other includes; bereavement, military, admin. leave, suspension, or other unpaid time off.



Noteworthy Cases:

On April 11, 2008 Chief Gregory was driving into the police department parking lot when he observed a subject later identified as Charlie Henry forcibly pulling a female victim out of the parking lot at 1440 Martin Street. The subject had what appeared to be a long handled butcher knife in his hand at the time. The victim stated that Henry had told her he was going to "stick" her with the knife.

The subjects were separated. Witnesses at scene indicated the male and female had been in a long-term abusive relationship. Henry arrived in a vehicle and jumped out and grabbed the victim and threatened to stab her with the knife. Charlie Henry was arrested and charged with disorderly conduct, use of a dangerous weapon. (08-94586)

On April 14, 2008 Dane County Human Services notified TMPD of a sexual assault of a 14-year-old child. Detective Hale conducted a lengthy and thorough investigation, which included numerous interviews, phone recordings and search warrants. The suspect in the incident was arrested and made numerous admissions regarding his activities. Anthony B Stelter was charged with repeated sexual assault of a child, incest with a child and intimidation of a victim. (08-95132)

On April 15, 2008 the victim in this incident purchased a vehicle, which broke down in a parking lot on Rimrock Road. The title was left in the vehicle and while making arrangements with her husband to come and get the vehicle, someone entered the vehicle and stole the title.

A tow truck came and a subject identified as Marcus Taylor was in the process of selling the vehicle to the tow company, using the title he obtained from the vehicle. Detective Krause interviewed the suspect, who admitted to trying to sell the vehicle and also admitted he has done this with at least six cars in the past few months. Taylor was charged with forgery for signing over the title. (08-98249)

On April 22, 2008 Officer Pucillo was on patrol in the Greenway Cross area when he observed a vehicle which was reported stolen in the city of Madison. Officer Pucillo stopped the vehicle on Perry Street; the driver exited the vehicle and ran. Officer Pucillo directed K-9 Brando to pursue the driver and Brando caught up to the suspect and bit the suspect and held him for Officer Pucillo. But as Officer Pucillo was about to contact the driver he was forced to confront a passenger in the vehicle. K-9 Brando immediately let go of the driver and went back to Officer Pucillo. The driver then escaped. The driver was identified as Rommell Smith. Officer Pucillo located the driver several days later and arrested him, charging him with operating a motor vehicle without owner's consent, two counts of obstructing and possession of drug paraphernalia. On April 24, 2008 Officer Pucillo was dispatched to the Capitol Motel to investigate a report of a disturbance. Officer Pucillo made contact with a female who was the victim of a battery. The female informed Pucillo that a friend of hers by the name of Reginald Costic had confronted her, grabbed her throat with one hand and pushed her backward to the ground striking the back of her head on the concrete. He then hit her on the left side of her head while continuing to strangle her. Costic was arrested and charged with strangulation and suffocation, battery and bail jumping. (08-107619)

On April 30, 2008 Officer Mansavage was dispatched to the Alhambra Place Apartments due to a report of a fight in the parking lot. On arrival he contacted a male subject who indicated the problem was caused by his girlfriend, Jennifer Randolph, who was upset because he was speaking to another female. The victim had a red area on his shoulder where she had bitten him. They argued inside then moved outside where she attempted to strike him and spit on him. Randolph then obtained a knife from her vehicle and came at the victim and tried to slash him with the knife. Two witnesses assisted in separating the victim from the suspect. Randolph was arrested and charged with battery, use of a dangerous weapon and disorderly conduct. (08-113742)

On April 30, 2008 Officer Pucillo was sent to a domestic disturbance on Badger Parkway. On arrival the female victim was found crying on the front steps. She stated she had gone out with some friends from work and upon arriving home her boyfriend Jeffery Chapell was upset. She states he is controlling and does not let her come and go as she wishes and beats her at least once a week. Tonight he punched her in the shoulder and chased her down the hallway and stairs and has locked her out for the past four hours.

Officer Pucillo and Sergeant Gehn attempted contact with Chapell and received no answer from inside. Permission was granted by the victim to force the door open and when officers entered they found Chapell pretending to be sleeping in the bedroom. Chapell said his name was Anthony and became uncooperative. He was identified by the victim and arrested for battery, disorderly conduct and obstructing. (08-113767)

Personnel Information

The department continued our January 2008 hiring process. On April 23, 2008 the Police and Fire Commission conducted interviews and forwarded six candidates to the chief of police for interviews. Those interviews were scheduled for early May.

Training

As with many other departments throughout Dane County, the State of Wisconsin, and the nation, police officer training is a hot topic, especially with the current budget situation in the state and our community. The department has made a commitment to our officers and community to constantly update their training as much as possible. Knowing that training is a budget item it is the department's desire to let the town board and community know how this money is being spent and what training is being offered to our officers.²
