EXPENDITURES

Personnel costs are normally the largest cost for any business; the police department is no exception in this arena. Due to the nature of law enforcement, not being able to predict call activity to any certainty, criminal activity causing overtime for investigative reasons, and for safety reasons (having to replace officers when they are unable to fill a scheduled shift due to sickness, injury, or other reason) the department's overtime costs are always a concern. Management attempts to minimize these costs as much as possible. Listed below is the monthly overtime costs year to date.

In addition to the above table, we are providing a greater detail of the type of overtime the department incurs on a monthly basis. The first table (OT by type) indicates what type of overtime the department incurred. The types of overtime are defined as:

OT-Court: Overtime associated with an officer attending municipal or criminal court or an officer acting as a Court Officer for municipal court.

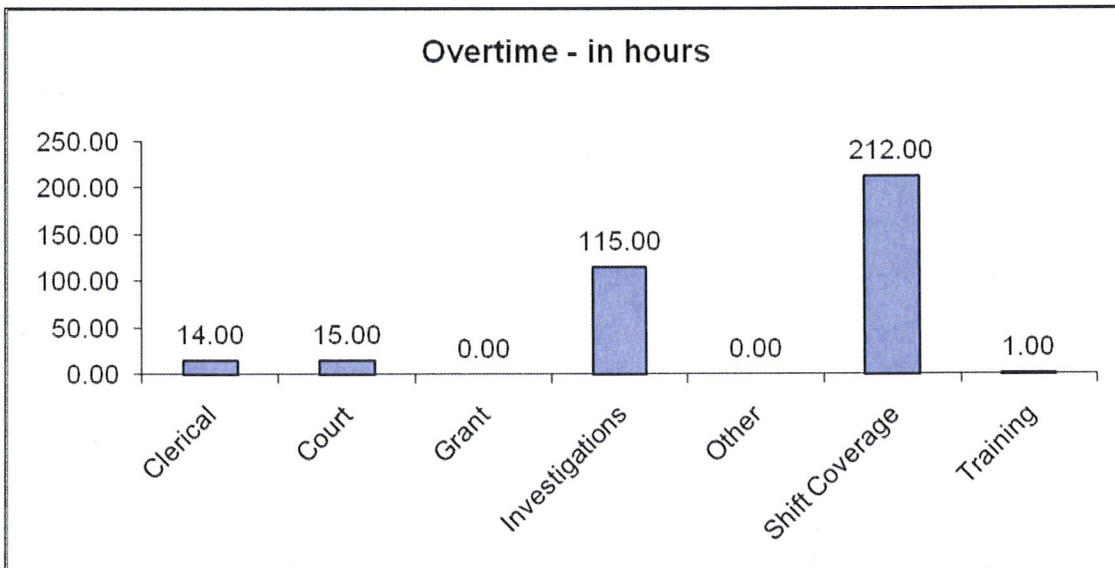
OT-Grant: The department is normally reimbursed from another agency for overtime-related costs in these categories.

OT-Investigations: Includes all overtime related to investigations (shift extension, early call-in, investigations)

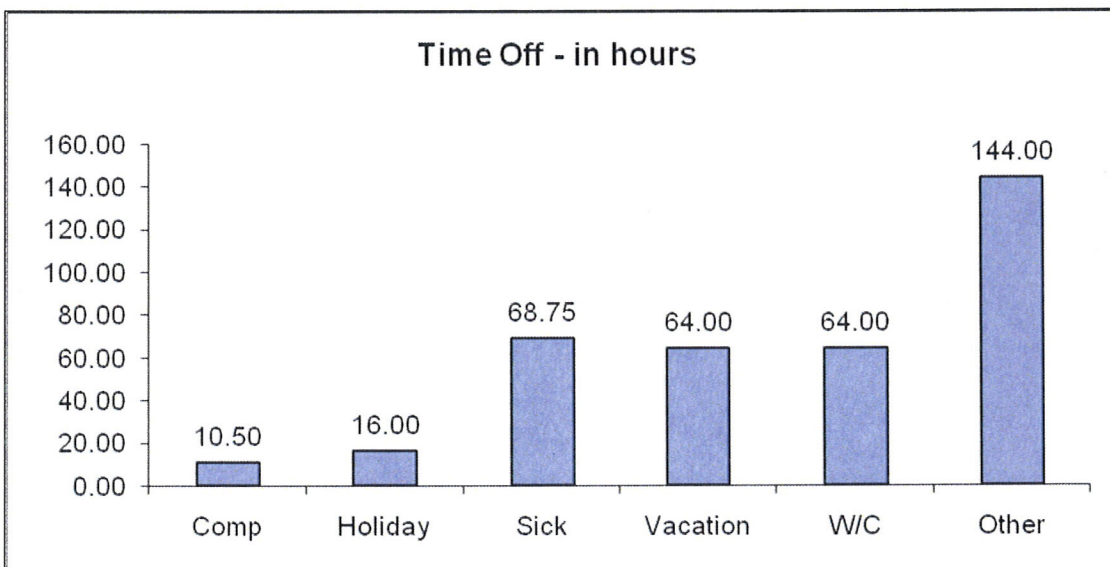
OT-Other: Uncategorized overtime

OT-Shift Coverage: All overtime related to filling in for an officer who is on vacation, sick, holiday, or otherwise unavailable to work the regularly scheduled shift.

OT-Training: Includes all overtime related to that individual officer to attend training



This table explains why an officer may not have appeared to work for their regularly scheduled shift. Time Off other includes; bereavement, military, admin. leave, suspension, or other unpaid time off.



Noteworthy Cases:

On February 2, 2008 Officer Wege and Officer Fischer were dispatched to Crocus Circle to investigate a report of a father beating his daughter. On arrival Officer Wege made contact with a witness in the driveway who stated that inside the residence the father was punching and kicking his daughter. The suspect had forced the witness to leave the residence.

Officer Wege and Officer Fischer entered the residence and made contact with the father. Officer Wege requested the suspect to step outside so he could speak with him. The suspect refused and Officer Wege and Officer Fischer had to pick him up and carry him out of the residence where he was arrested; he was incarcerated under charges of resisting and physical abuse of a child. On February 9, 2008 Officer Parks and Officer Withee were sent to the 2600 block of Pheasant Ridge Trail where a subject was reportedly beating a woman. On arrival the officers heard loud yelling, swearing and arguing coming from inside the residence. Officer Parks made contact with the victim who said she was six months pregnant. Her ex-boyfriend, who is not the father of her unborn child, came to her house. The suspect, identified as Angel Trujillo, came inside and threw a television set on the ground and pulled a mattress off of a bed. He also threw the victim down and in her condition she was not able to get up. Officer Withee arrested the suspect and charged him with domestic disorderly conduct. (Case # 08-34966)

On February 20, 2008 Officer Parks was dispatched to an address on Woodview Court to investigate a report of a woman being beaten. On arrival Officer Parks made contact with the female victim who was out of breath and crying. Officer Parks observed red marks and scratches on the victim's neck.

The argument started when the victim's boyfriend was playing loud music and refused to turn it down. He became upset when the victim turned the music down so she could watch a television show. He came at her and grabbed her by the throat and began squeezing her neck, he continued to do so and only quit when she pulled his hair. He picked up the television set and threw it to the floor and took garbage and scattered it throughout the apartment. Charges were forwarded to the district attorney's office for domestic disorderly conduct, battery and criminal damage to property. (Case # 08-45137)

On February 20, 2008 Officer Wege observed a vehicle run a red light at the intersection of South Park Street and West Badger Road. Officer Wege stopped the vehicle and issued the driver John P. Walsh a citation for the traffic offense. After issuing the citation Officer Wege asked the driver about the marijuana he could smell in the vehicle. The subject attempted to put the vehicle in drive; however Officer Wege opened the door and ordered the subject out. He exited the vehicle and was uncooperative; he walked backwards toward the squad car and Officer Wege handcuffed him, to detain him so that a drug investigation could be conducted.

Officer Wege searched the vehicle and found a baggie of marijuana under the front seat. Officer Wege interviewed Walsh who stated he had purchased it on Monroe Street about 3 hours earlier for \$400. The marijuana was later found to weigh over 59 grams. Walsh was arrested for possession of marijuana with intent to deliver. (Case # 08-46797)

On February 19, 2008 Detective Krause obtained information that there was drug activity at an address on Deer Valley Road. This information was relayed to Officer Pucillo who had K-9 Brando conduct a sniff in the hallway of the suspect apartment building. Brando alerted to the odor of controlled substances at one of the apartment doors in the building.

Based on the previous information and the drug sniff, Detective Krause wrote a search warrant, which was signed by a judge. The Town of Madison Police Department High Risk and Apprehension Team served the warrant and searched for controlled substances. They located over 11 grams of marijuana, an electronic scale and grinder, marijuana blunts, a crack pipe and baggies. Several subjects were arrested on warrants and Vansha Campbell was arrested for possession of marijuana. (Case # 08-45722)

On February 28, 2008 Officer Pucillo heard the Madison Police broadcast information on a stolen red Pontiac. While on routine patrol Officer Pucillo observed a vehicle southbound on Cypress Way matching the description of the stolen vehicle. Officer Pucillo observed the vehicle turn into a driveway and he approached on verified the this was the stolen vehicle. The vehicle became stuck in the snow and the driver was spinning the tires attempting to get it leave. Officer Pucillo approached the vehicle with K-9 Brando. It appeared the driver was going to run, however Brando began barking and the suspect took the keys out of the vehicle and complied with Officer Pucillo's orders.

The vehicle was searched and over 8 grams of cocaine and approximately 4 grams of marijuana were found. James Watts, the driver, was arrested for the drugs and for operating a motor vehicle without owners consent. There were also active warrants out for his arrest at the time of this incident. (Case #53731)

Personnel Information

Officer Chris McAtee resigned on February 17 Officer Terry Loos resigned on February 22. The January 2008 hiring process is continuing. The deadline for applications was February 15. We received 98 applications and offered the written test to 87 applicants. The written test is scheduled for March 8 and the Police Panel Interviews will be April 8, 9 and 10.

Training

As with many other departments throughout Dane County, the State of Wisconsin, and the nation, police officer training is a hot topic, especially with the current budget situation in the state and our community. The department has made a commitment to our officers and community to constantly update their training as much as possible. Knowing that training is a budget item it is the department's desire to let the town board and community know how this money is being spent and what training is being offered to our officers.
