EXPENDITURES

Personnel costs are normally the largest cost for any business; the police department is no exception in this arena. Due to the nature of law enforcement, not being able to predict call activity to any certainty, criminal activity causing overtime for investigative reasons, and for safety reasons (having to replace officers when they are unable to fill a scheduled shift due to sickness, injury, or other reason) the department's overtime costs are always a concern. Management attempts to minimize these costs as much as possible. Listed below is the monthly overtime costs year to date.

In addition to the above tables, we are providing a greater detail of the type of overtime the department incurs on a monthly basis. The first table (OT by type) indicates what type of overtime the department incurred. The types of overtime are defined as:

OT-Court: Overtime associated with an officer attending municipal or criminal court or an officer acting as a Court Officer for municipal court.

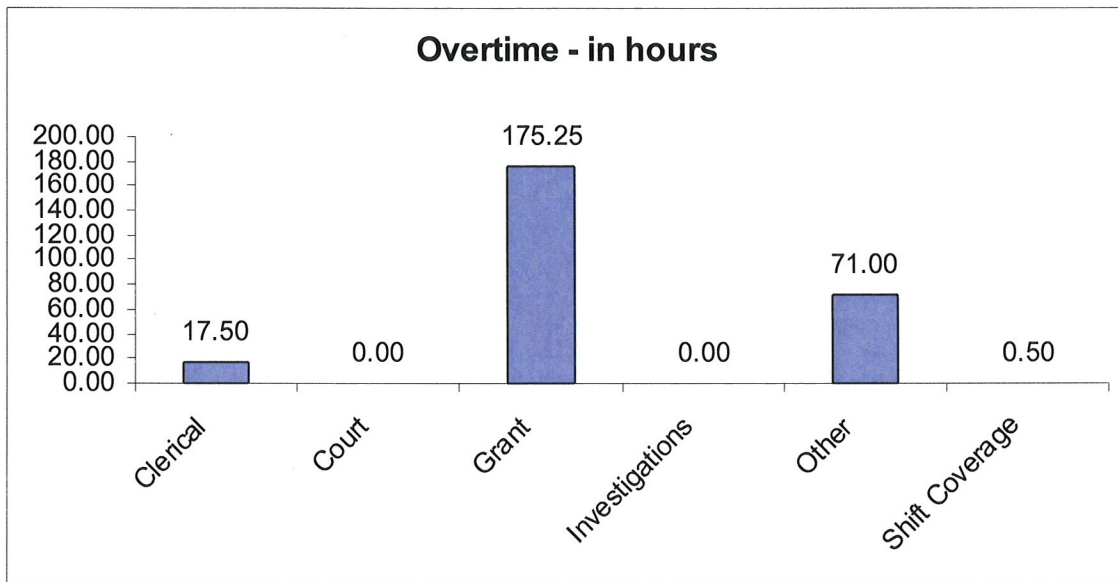
OT-Grant: The department is normally reimbursed from another agency for overtime-related costs in these categories.

OT-Investigations: Includes all overtime related to investigations (shift extension, early call-in, investigations)

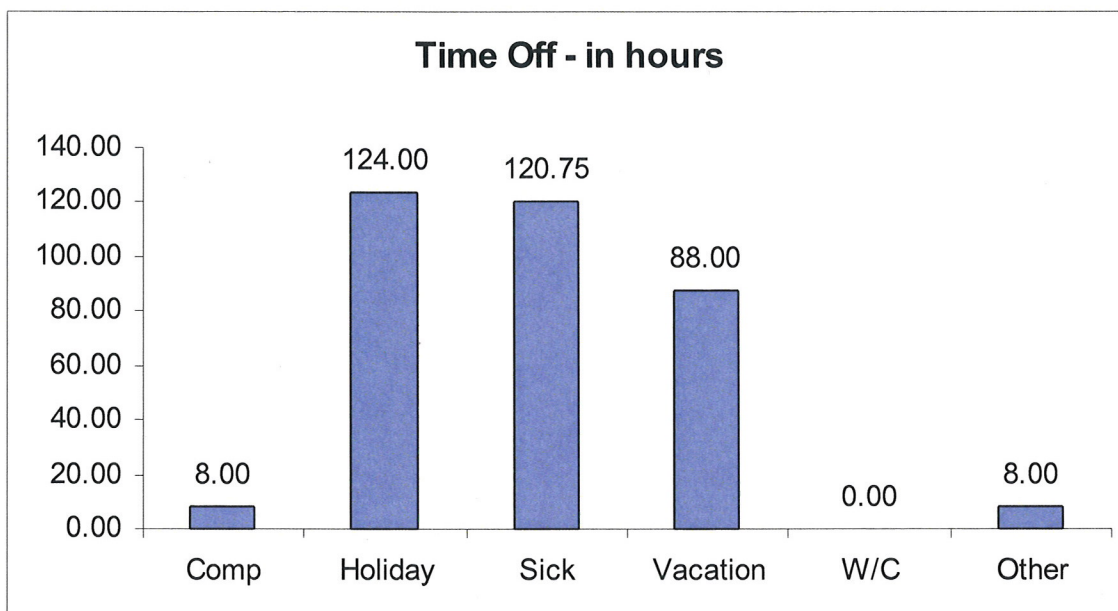
OT-Other: Uncategorized overtime

OT-Shift Coverage: All overtime related to filling in for an officer who is on vacation, sick, holiday, or otherwise unavailable to work the regularly scheduled shift.

OT-Training: Includes all overtime related to that individual officer to attend training



This table explains the reasons an officer may not have appeared to work for their regularly scheduled shift. Time Off other includes; bereavement, military, Admin. Leave, suspension, or other unpaid time off.



Noteworthy Cases:

On January 2, 2008 Officer Pucillo was dispatched to Lakewood Gardens Blvd, to investigate a report of a vehicle doing doughnuts in the parking lot, and a woman screaming and hitting the car with something.

Officers found the woman in her residence bruised and bleeding from numerous areas on her face. Her apartment door had been broken in and she was attacked, choked and beaten by her boyfriend Christopher Burns.

The incident began when the victim and her boyfriend had an argument and she told him to leave. Later she took the trash to the dumpster and he began revving his vehicle's engine and drove the car behind her running it into her. She began striking the vehicle with a hammer causing a large amount of damage to the vehicle. The victim ran back to her apartment and locked the door and Burns exited his vehicle and followed her to the apartment where he began kicking in the door and yelling that he was going to kill her. He eventually caved the door in and stormed into the living room area and grabbed the victim by her throat and threw her onto the dining room table. He began strangling her yelling that he was going to kill her. He hit her 4-5 times in the face with his fists. The victim's jaw was later found to be broken and the orbital bone around her right eye was also fractured.

The next evening Officer Pucillo and Sergeant Gehn responded to the suspect's place of employment on East Washington Avenue and located Burns. Burns was arrested and jailed under charges of burglary, substantial battery, criminal damage to property and disorderly conduct. (Case # 08-141)

On January 5, 2008 a male victim parked his vehicle, a gray Mercury Topaz, in front of the Open Pantry on Rimrock Road and left it with the keys in it and the motor running. After 3-4 minutes in the store he returned to where he had parked and found that his vehicle was gone.

On January 8, 2008 Officer Terry Loos was on routine patrol when he observed the reported stolen vehicle operating eastbound on West Badger Road near Park Street. Officer Loos requested backup and followed the vehicle to the 600 block of East Badger Road where he affected a high-risk traffic stop on the vehicle. Two juvenile suspects in the vehicle were taken into custody and both were arrested. The driver was charged with operating a motor vehicle without owners consent. (Case # 08-4166)

On January 9, 2008 Town of Madison Police were sent to 216 Deer Valley Road regarding a man that had just been shot. Officer Wege and Boldebuck responded and on arrival located the victim, who was shot in the chest.

Officer Wege learned from witnesses that the shooting had resulted from an argument that occurred in a back parking lot. A pistol magazine and empty shell casings were found at the scene. The suspect was a male by the name of Rob who left in a black vehicle. City of Madison Police recently had contact with a Robert Robinson in a vehicle matching this description.

Detective Hale obtained a photo lineup of Robert Robinson and showed it to the victim while at the hospital where he was being treated. The victim positively identified Robinson as the person who had shot him. A warrant for attempted homicide was obtained and entered into the computer system.

Robert Robinson was arrested in Appleton on January 18, 2008 during an unrelated drug search warrant by the Appleton Police Department. Detective Hale and Detective Krause drove to the Winnebago County Jail and conducted an interview with Robinson who provided information about the shooting and provided information regarding the gun that was used in this shooting. Officer Pucillo was given the information about the gun's possible location in Monona. Officer Pucillo, with the assistance of the Monona Police Department located the loaded .45 caliber pistol in a snow bank. Robinson was charged with attempted 1st degree intentional homicide. (Case # 08-7408)

Officer Tony Pucillo was dispatched to 217 Deer Valley Road to a report of an ex-boyfriend kicking in the apartment door and entering the residence. The caller was fearful because she had broken up with the suspect because he had battered her in the past.

On Officer Pucillo's arrival the victim identified her ex-boyfriend as Nicholas Madison. She said she was in her apartment with a male friend talking when the suspect kicked in the back door and entered the residence. The suspect approached the victim and acted like he was going to hit her but only swore at her and left.

Officer Pucillo and Officer Loos responded to the suspect's residence where he was arrested for disorderly conduct, criminal damage to property and criminal trespass to a dwelling. (Case # 08-12587)

On January 24, 2008 Officer Loos was dispatched to the parking lot behind 2621 Pheasant Ridge Trail to investigate a report of suspicious persons. Officer Loos responded and observed a van that he recognized as being reported stolen by the Dane County Sheriff's Department. As Officer Loos approached the stolen van a male, later identified as Jammie Hunter, exited the vehicle and started to walk toward the building. Officer Loos held the subject at gunpoint until the arrival of Officer Pucillo. Prior to Hunter being handcuffed, he was observed throwing a baggie to the ground and stepping on it and twisting his foot back and forth on it. Hunter was then secured and the baggie recovered. The baggie contained 1.66 grams of crack cocaine, Hunter was charged with possession of cocaine. (Case # 08-19589)

On January 27, 2008 Officer Wege was on routine patrol and observed a suspicious vehicle in a parking lot behind 2617 Pheasant Ridge Trail where there has been an increase of drug activity recently. Officer Wege approached the vehicle and it hurriedly exited the parking lot and proceeded to Hazelwood Court where it pulled into a parking stall to try to hide. Officer Wege contacted the driver and his female passenger. Officer Pucillo and K-9 Brando conducted a sniff for drugs which resulted in Brando alerting for controlled substances. Officer Wege searched the female's purse and located contraband. The female was later interviewed and she provided information about a residence at 2621 Pheasant Ridge Trail #4, where she purchased the cocaine.

Detective Krause wrote a search warrant based on the information obtained by Officer Wege. On January 27, 2008 the Town of Madison High Risk Apprehension Team served the search warrant. A female occupant was arrested on a warrant and the residence was searched. A male resident, identified as Jammie Hunter, was arrested and charged with possession of cocaine base with intent to deliver, possession of marijuana and maintaining a drug dwelling. Personnel Information

Officer Stephens and Officer McAtee began solo patrol duties on January 1, 2008. Officer Surillo continued in his field training status.

Training

As with many other departments throughout Dane County, the State of Wisconsin, and the nation, police officer training is a hot topic, especially with the current budget situation in the state and our community. The department has made a commitment to our officers and community to constantly update their training as much as possible. Knowing that training is a budget item it is the department's desire to let the town board and community know how this money is being spent and what training is being offered to our officers.
