EXPENDITURES

Personnel costs are normally the largest cost for any business; the police department is no exception in this arena. Due to the nature of law enforcement, not being able to predict call activity to any certainty, criminal activity causing overtime for investigative reasons, and for safety reasons (having to replace officers when they are unable to fill a scheduled shift due to sickness, injury, or other reason) the department's overtime costs are always a concern. Management attempts to minimize these costs as much as possible. Listed below is the monthly overtime costs year to date.

In addition to the above table, we are providing a greater detail of the type of overtime the department incurs on a monthly basis. The first table (OT by type) indicates what type of overtime the department incurred. The types of overtime are defined as:

OT-Court: Overtime associated with an officer attending municipal or criminal court or an officer acting as a Court Officer for municipal court.

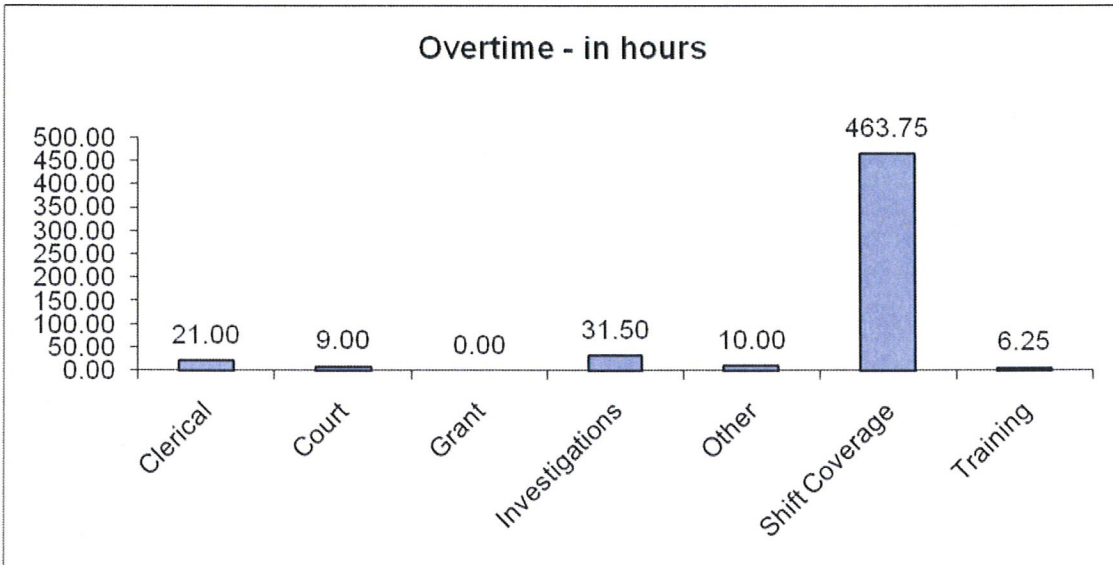
OT-Grant: The department is normally reimbursed from another agency for overtime-related costs in these categories.

OT-Investigations: Includes all overtime related to investigations (shift extension, early call-in, investigations)

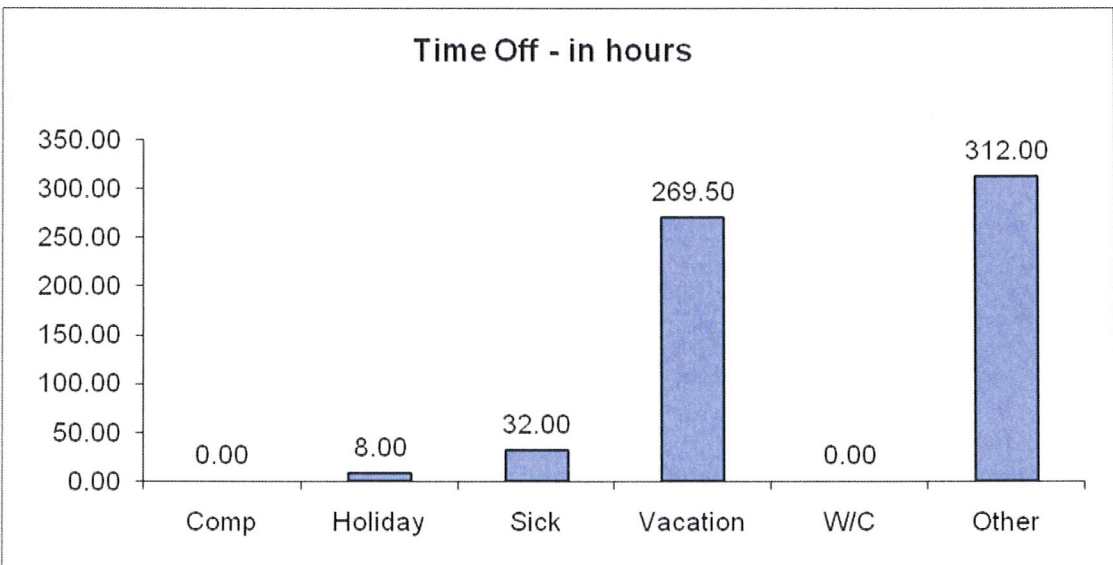
OT-Other: Uncategorized overtime

OT-Shift Coverage: All overtime related to filling in for an officer who is on vacation, sick, holiday, or otherwise unavailable to work the regularly scheduled shift.

OT-Training: Includes all overtime related to that individual officer to attend training



This table explains why an officer may not have appeared to work for their regularly scheduled shift. Time Off other includes; bereavement, military, admin. leave, suspension, or other unpaid time off.



Noteworthy Cases:

On March 2, 2008 Detective Hale was dispatched to Deer Valley Road to check out a report of a female "out of control." Detective Hale obtained a description and located the suspect who was on foot and in an extremely distraught condition.

Detective Hale returned the suspect to her residence where he learned from witnesses that the suspect had become upset and began yelling and screaming and had taken a flashlight and smashed a door jam leading into the children's bedroom.

Detective Hale noticed a bruise on the forehead of the suspect's 15-month-old child. He investigated and learned from a witness that the suspect had aggressively pushed the child and had thrown her 3-4 feet causing her to be injured. The suspect was arrested for physical abuse of a child. (Case # 08-57275)

On March 6, 2008 Officer Mansavage was on routine patrol and observed a subject operating a silver Ford Crown Victoria acting suspiciously. Officer Mansavage attempted to stop the vehicle on the beltline near Todd Drive. The suspect attempted to flee Officer Mansavage and proceeded onto Seminole Highway and then back eastbound on the beltline. Officer Mansavage chased the suspect at speeds up to 105 miles per hour. The suspect exited at Rimrock Road and proceeded to Engelhart Drive where he ran into a snow bank and then got out and ran on foot. His footprints were followed to a location on Sunnyvale Lane where the suspect, identified as Courtney Miller, was found hiding near a dumpster.

Miller was identified by Officer Mansavage as the driver of the vehicle and was arrested and charged with obstructing, eluding an officer, drivers view obstruction, and second degree recklessly endangering safety. (Case # 08-60487)

On March 10, 2008 Officers Wege and Fischer were dispatched to an address on Ashford Lane to investigate a report of a disturbance between a male and female in the hallway of the apartment building. Officer Wege arrived and made contact with a female sitting on the hallway steps. The female was upset and had injuries to her head behind her ear and on her forearm.

Officer Wege learned that the female victim was in an apartment with the suspect Jonathan Stanley. Stanley requested oral sex from the victim and when she refused he threw a beer in her face. They began to argue and the victim felt her safety was in danger and attempted to leave the apartment. The suspect grabbed her and pulled her back into the apartment and began throwing her around the room. The suspect slapped and punched her as well. The suspect said he was going to throw her over the balcony and another female stepped in to prevent this from occurring. The suspect picked up the victim by her waist and hair and threw her out of the apartment into the hallway.

Officers Wege and Fischer arrested Jonathan Stanley for battery and disorderly conduct. The victim was also arrested on outstanding warrants. (Case # 08-64615)

On March 22, 2008 Officer Pucillo was conducting a routine bar check at Pitcher's Pub when the bar manager pointed out an individual whom he suspected of having a fake ID. Officer Pucillo contacted the suspect, who had trouble identifying himself and remembering his birth date. The suspect then refused to answer any further investigative questions and was placed under arrest. Upon being searched incident to arrest two packages of cocaine were found on his person. The subject was later identified as William Diaz-Escobar.

As Officer Pucillo was about to leave with Diaz-Escobar another subject identified as Roger Ruiz approached Officer Pucillo and stated he had given Diaz-Escobar his driver's license to use. Ruiz was then cited for allowing a minor to use his identification to ingest alcohol within a licensed establishment. Diaz-Escobar was charged with possession of cocaine and obstructing an officer. (Case #08-75526)

On March 25, 2008 Sergeant Gehn and Officer Pucillo were dispatched to the Alhambra apartment complex to investigate a report of a female crying and screaming and being beaten by a male subject. Officer Pucillo arrived approximately 30 seconds ahead of Sergeant Gehn and as Officer Pucillo entered the building a male subject jumped out of a bedroom window and landed in front of Sergeant Gehn who just arrived. The subject was taken into custody and identified as Daniel Brownridge.

Sergeant Gehn interviewed the female victim and learned that her boyfriend Brownridge had two friends over and he apparently became angry because she was talking to them. He grabbed her by the neck and pushed her into the bedroom where he began punching her in the face and head with his fists. After several minutes he stopped and dragged her by her hair out into the living room area where he got on top of her and began punching her in the face and head again.

Brownridge stopped beating the victim and she got up and tried to run out the door, however he grabbed her by the hair just as she was exiting and dragged her back into the apartment where she fell down and he again punched and kicked her in the sides. Daniel Brownridge was arrested and charged with battery, false imprisonment and felony intimidation of a victim. (Case # 08-78015)

On March 29, 2008 Officer Boldebuck and Officer Anderson were sent to Capitol View Terrace to check on a female who was on a balcony and requesting the police be sent. While enroute the officers were informed that a suspect might have kicked in the door to the female's residence.

Upon arrival the officers found that the door to the apartment had been kicked in; the lock was bent and splinters were in the dead bolt area. The Officers announced their presence and entered the residence; they observed an 8" knife lying on the kitchen floor. Officer Boldebuck could hear a noise coming from the kitchen and ordered whoever was there to come out. A female emerged from behind a wall and Officer Boldebuck asked if there was anyone else there. The female shook her head yes and pointed toward the wall to let the officers know someone was there. Officer Boldebuck ordered him out and Jerome Berry the suspect in the incident came out and was taken into custody.

It was learned from the victim that Berry had forced the door open and had held her at knifepoint while attempting to get her to have sex with him. The victim stated that she

believed she would have been stabbed or raped, had the officers not come in and stopped him. Jerome Berry was arrested and charged with burglary while armed, false imprisonment, intimidation of a victim and possession of drug paraphernalia. (Case # 08-823060)

Personnel Information

We received 98 applications and offered the written test to 87 applicants. The written test was on March 8. The results were received near the end of March. Interviews were offered to 41 applicants with the police panel. This interview will take place April 8-10.

Training

As with many other departments throughout Dane County, the State of Wisconsin, and the nation, police officer training is a hot topic, especially with the current budget situation in the state and our community. The department has made a commitment to our officers and community to constantly update their training as much as possible. Knowing that training is a budget item it is the department's desire to let the town board and community know how this money is being spent and what training is being offered to our officers.²
