COMPLAINING WITNESS

Gebler/Zwart/Turner/Nitzsche

The above-named complaining witness being first duly sworn states the following:

Count 1: ARMED ROBBERY

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, February 14, 2007, in the City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, with intent to steal, did take property from the person or presence of the owner, Gary Power, by use or threatening use of a dangerous weapon, contrary to sec. 943.32(2), 939.50(3)(c) Wis. Stats., a Class C Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), or imprisoned not more than forty (40) years, or both.

Count 2: ARMED ROBBERY

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, February 15, 2007, in the Town of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, with intent to steal, did take property from the person or presence of the owner, Serria Williams, by use or threatening use of a dangerous weapon, contrary to sec. 943.32(2), 939.50(3)(c) Wis. Stats., a Class C Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), or imprisoned not more than forty (40) years, or both.

Count 3: ARMED ROBBERY

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, February 15, 2007, in the Town of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, with intent to steal, did take property from the person or presence of the owner, Derek J Meyer, by use or threatening use of a dangerous weapon, contrary to sec. 943.32(2), 939.50(3)(c) Wis. Stats., a Class C Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), or imprisoned not more than forty (40) years, or both.

Count 4: ARMED ROBBERY

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, February 15, 2007, in the Town of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, with intent to steal, did take property from the person or presence of the owner, Harjit Singh, by use or threatening use of a dangerous weapon, contrary to sec. 943.32(2), 939.50(3)(c) Wis. Stats., a Class C Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), or imprisoned not more than forty (40) years, or both.

Count 5: ARMED ROBBERY

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, February 22, 2007, in the City of Monona, Dane County, Wisconsin, with intent to steal, did take property from the person or presence of the owner, Antonio Williams, by use or threatening use of a dangerous weapon, contrary to sec. 943.32(2), 939.50(3)(c) Wis. Stats., a Class C Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), or imprisoned not more than forty (40) years, or both.

Count 6: ARMED ROBBERY

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, February 22, 2007, in the City of Fitchburg, Dane County, Wisconsin, with intent to steal, did take property from the person or presence of the owner, Michael Moore, by use or threatening use of a dangerous weapon, contrary to sec. 943.32(2), 939.50(3)(c) Wis. Stats., a Class C Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), or imprisoned not more than forty (40) years, or both.

FACTS:

Count 1. (MAPD 07-15901) MAPD Officer Michael Franklin reports the following: On **02/14/07 at 2:12 am**, he and other officers were dispatched to the **BP Gas Station at 4222 W Washington Avenue** in the City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, regarding a report of an armed robbery that had just occurred. There, he spoke with station attendant Gary Power, who stated the following: The robber selected a bottle of Maalox, brought it to the counter and asked if it was good for heartburn and gas. Power told him it was. The robber lifted his sweater, displaying what appeared to be a black handgun, and stated, "I need you to place the drawer out here on the counter." Power did so. The robber took the cash without consent. The robber said, "I'm sorry I'm doing this, but I've got credit problems."

Count 2. (TMPD 07-14742) TMPD Officer Todd Dart reports that on **02/15/07 at 3:57 am**, he was dispatched to the **Open Pantry at 2504 Rimrock Rd** in the Town of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, regarding the report of an armed robbery that had just occurred. There, he spoke with clerk Sirrea Williams, who stated the following: The robber came into the store and spoke to another employee about buying a laptop computer. He also asked this employee for a ride, which she declined. He approached two customers in the store, who also declined to give him a ride. An employee told him to leave. He produced a handgun, a black semi-automatic. He pulled the slide back, released it, pointed it directly at herself, other employees and a customer, and demanded money. She was unable to open

the till, so another employee helped her. She handed the robber money from the till. After he had this money, he pointed the gun at the customer, Derek Meyer, who also gave him money. He left with the money, without consent.

Detective Darrick Krause reports that on 02/16/07, he showed Sierra Williams a series of photographs taken from DCSO records and she identified one of the photos identified by said records as that of the defendant herein as the person who robbed the Open Pantry and Derek Meyer, as described.

Count 3. Officer Dart reports that he spoke with Derek Meyer, who stated that he was a customer in the store when a robber came in, pointed a gun at an employee and stated, "Everyone get down." No one did. The robber demanded that Williams open the till and give him money. After he took the money from the till, the robber pointed the gun directly at him and stated something to the effect of, "I don't even like white people." Meyer took \$30 from his wallet and gave it to the robber, who took it without his consent. The robber talked about going to jail soon. Then left.

Count 4. (TMPD 07-14986) TMPD Officer Kurt Wege reports that on **02/15/07 at 7:35 pm**, he was dispatched to the **BP station at 2050 Fish Hatchery Road** in the Town of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, regarding a report of an armed robbery that had just occurred. There, he spoke with Harjit Singh, who reported the following: The robber selected a bottle of Advil and came to the register as if to pay for it. Singh rang up the purchase. The robber leaned slightly over the counter and unzipped his jacket, revealing a large black handgun. As the robber reached for the gun, he told Singh to open the register. The robber told Singh not to move. Singh removed the paper currency from the register. The robber took it, without consent, put it in his jacket pocket and started toward the door. He turned and said, "Sorry" and left.

Count 5. (MOPD 07-1048) Monona Police Department Officer Kevin Schneider reports that on **02/22/07, at 1:50 am**, he was dispatched to the **Speedway station on Royal Avenue** in the City of Monona, Dane County, Wisconsin, about an armed robbery that had just occurred. There he spoke with clerk Antonio Williams, who stated the following: The robber approached the counter with a box of Excedrin and asked for two cartons of Newport cigarettes. Williams went to the back to get the cartons of cigarettes. When he returned, the robber asked him if he watched the news. Williams said that he did not. The robber told Williams to look over the counter. The robber stretched the waistband of his pants. Williams declined to look. The robber said, "No, look down here." Williams did look, and saw the handle of a gun. The robber told him to pull out the cash drawer and put it on the counter, which he did. The robber took the paper currency from the drawer. The robber told Williams that he was sorry and told Williams not to call police, because someone was watching outside. The robber grabbed the three cartons of cigarettes and left with them and the money, without consent. Officer Tracy Thom reports that on 02/22/07, he showed Williams a photo lineup and Williams identified one of the six photographs as that of the robber. The photographs are taken from records kept and maintained in the course of official duties by the DCSO, which records identify the photograph identified by Williams as that of the defendant herein.

Count 6. (FTPD 07-2715) City of Fitchburg Police Department officer Cory Brandl reports that on **02/22/07 at 11:16 pm**, he was dispatched to the **Stop N Go store on Fish Hatchery Road** in the City of Fitchburg, Dane County, Wisconsin, regarding an armed

robbery that had just occurred. There, he spoke with clerk, Michael Moore, who stated the following: The robber approached the counter and said, "The first thing I need you to do is open up the drawer." Moore reached for a panic alarm, but the robber told him not to touch it, and again demanded he open the drawer. The robber had partially revealed a black semi automatic handgun, which he put back into his pocket. Moore set the cash drawer on the counter. The robber grabbed all of the cash, said "I'm sorry," and left with the money, without consent.

TMPD Detective Rob Hale reports that on 02/23/07, the defendant herein was arrested for a probation violation. Detective Hale reports that he identified the defendant from previous contact. Detective Hale drove the defendant to all of the above locations, and at each location the defendant acknowledged that he had committed the above-described armed robberies.

Your complainant is a detective for the City of Madison Police Department. Your complainant believes the sources for this complaint reliable because the officers' reports were written in the course of official duties; the statements of citizen witnesses are based on personal knowledge; and those of the defendant are against his penal interest.
