Suspect Description:

Robert Echols, described as a 24 year old black male, 6'01", 190 lbs., last seen wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with a photo of a male and the words "RIP Kuz." Victim(s)/Injuries:

The victim sustained a non-life threatening gunshot injury and was transported to a nearby hospital.

Details of Incident:

On 11/27/2008 at 9:50pm, Town of Madison Police Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Alhambra Place for a report of a person who had been shot. A female victim was transported to a nearby hospital for non life-threatening injuries. It appears that the injured female was not the intended victim and is known to the suspect. The intended victim was not hurt and is safe.

As a result of the investigation, the Town of Madison Police Department have probable cause for the arrest of Robert Echols. He is described as 6'01", 190 lbs and is 24 years old. He was last seen wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with a photo of a male and the words "RIP Kuz." He fled on foot and is believed to be in possession of a handgun. It is unknown if Echols has access to any vehicles. He is known to have contacts in Milwaukee and Chicago, as well as the Madison area.

If anyone sees Echols, keep a safe distance and call 911.
