Details of Incident:

Town of Madison Police was dispatched to a report of a disturbance at 2718 Pheasant Ridge Trail. Arriving officers located a male victim, bleeding severely from numerous stab wounds, lying in the snow near the entrance to the building. The victim was transported to a local hospital where he underwent surgery and is currently in stable condition.

Police learned that the victim and the female suspect were in an apartment with the apartment's occupant. A short time later the male suspect arrived at the apartment. A physical altercation began between the victim and the male suspect. The male suspect pulled out a knife and began slashing and stabbing the victim. The victim was able to get the male suspect to drop the knife in the struggle, at which time the female suspect picked up the knife and began slashing the victim with it. Both suspects then went through the victim's clothing and stole an undetermined amount of cash. The suspects then jumped out of an apartment window while the victim staggered outside to get help.

Description of suspects:

- #1 Black male, approximately 5'10", 170 lbs., 25-30 years old.
- #2 White female, Approximately 5'6", 140 lbs., 25-30 years old.
