### **Details of Incident:**

The Town of Madison recently notified the public we would be stepping OWI and speed enforcement.

On April 17 between 11:00 am and 3:00 pm the Town of Madison conducted a concentrated speed enforcement effort targeting on Hwy 14 and the adjoining roadways. During this time we issued 63 citations; this included 15 seatbelt citations and 1 child safety restraint violation. The highest speed violation was 29 mph over the speed limit. We also issued 10 written warnings.

Overall, the department had four officers and the police chief dedicated to this effort in addition to our regularly scheduled officers.

The Town of Madison Police Department would like to remind all drivers not to drive when you have been drinking; drive the speed limit and wear your safety belts. The Town of Madison Police Department will be conducting sporadic OWI and concentrated speed enforcement efforts utilizing grant funding from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Bureau of Transportation Safety.
