## SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION BULLETIN

January 19, 2009

The Town of Madison Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.46(2m) which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release when; in the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety, awareness and protection. The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of sex offenses. Further, his criminal history places him in a classification level, which reflects the potential to re-offend.

This offender has served the incarceration sentence imposed on him by the courts. **He is NOT wanted by the police at this time.** *This notification is not intended to increase fear, rather, it is our belief that an informed public is a safer public.*

Sex offenders **have always** lived in our communities; but it was not until Act 440 was enacted that law enforcement is able to share this information with the community.

**Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered sex offenders will NOT be tolerated.**

**CORTEZ SHIELDS** has been released on parole for convictions of 2ND DEGREE SEXUAL ASSAULT OF A CHILD; 3RD DEGREE SEXUAL ASSAULT-HABITUAL CRIMINAL; BATTERY BY PRISONER; SUBSTANTIAL BATTERY - INTENT BODILY HARM-HABITUAL CRIMINAL; 1ST DEGREE RECKLESS INJURY-HABITUAL CRIMINAL

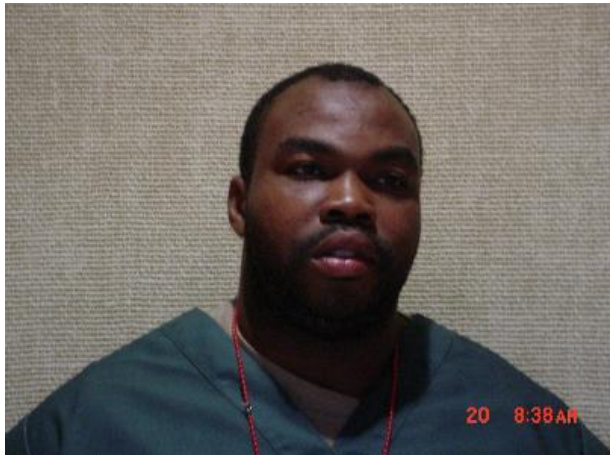
