Details of Incident:

The Town of Madison recently notified the public we would be stepping OWI and speed enforcement between March 13 and 20, 2009.

On March 20 between 11:00 am and 3:00 pm the Town of Madison conducted a concentrated speed enforcement effort on the W. Beltline Hwy. During this time we issued 43 citations; 34 speed citations (high speed was 83 mph), 2 seat belt citations, 1 operating after suspension, 1 operating after revocation, and a possession of marijuana citation. We also issued 4 written warnings.

Overall, the department had four officers and the police chief dedicated to this effort in addition to our regularly scheduled officers.

The Town of Madison Police Department would like to remind all drivers not to drive when you have been drinking; drive the speed limit and wear your safety belts. The Town of Madison Police Department will be conducting sporadic OWI and concentrated speed enforcement efforts utilizing grant funding from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Bureau of Transportation Safety.
