Arrested Person(s)/Suspect Description:

A 17 year old male was arrested and charged by the Dane County District Attorney's Office. The juvenile will not be identified in this media release.

Charges:

- Entry into a locked vehicle
- Misdemeanor theft (2 counts)

Details of Incident:

On Dec. 15, 2010 a 17 year male broke into two vehicles in the 2300 block of Badger Parkway. The suspect followed a person into one of the security locked buildings and tried to sell CD's that he just stole. He happened to try and sell the CD's to the owner of the vehicle he stole them from. The victim recognized the CD's as his and asked the suspect where he obtained them from and the victim and suspect went outside.

The victim's vehicle had a window covered with thick plastic and the victim observed the plastic was ripped off from the window. The suspect tried to run away, but the victim and his roommate held him there until police arrived.

Officers observed the suspect had vehicle registration in his possession, this registration erty belonged to a second victim. The department has recovered a satellite radio and an iPod; we have not been able to determine who owns this property.
