Details of Incident:

The Town of Madison Police Department received a number of complaints (13 complaints as of 11:00 am) regarding theft from vehicles in the neighborhood between Martin Street and Carver Street. Suspects entered unlocked vehicles and stole items ranging from coins, pens, electronic equipment and alcohol.

We would like to remind all citizens to lock your car doors. The thieves bypassed all locked vehicles and entered unlocked vehicles looking for small items then moved to the next vehicle.
